Introduction

Foundry Gridnik, a remarkable, distinctive and angular geometric design that is inspirational, versatile and an iconic typeface design by the much loved Dutch visionary, Wim Crouwel. Once described as 'the thinking man's Courier', derives from a typeface that was originally designed by Crouwel in the late 60s for Olivetti, as a single weight typewriter face, but it was never released as a font.

In the original idea that Crouwel had developed for Olivetti he used a basic unit of 7. Using multiples of this he arrived at a stem width of 56. From this it was easy to calculate the new weights, halving it for the light to a stem width of 28, adding half again to make a stem width of 84 for the medium, and lastly doubling it to make 112 for the bold. This was entirely in keeping with Crouwel's thinking. An additional Extra Bold weight has been designed to fit this system along with Italic weights with the full approval from Crouwel.
